Qualifications

- Applicants must be 18 or older.
- Currently studying acting at a university or within the field.
- Must intend to pursue acting as a career.

Purpose and Goals

The purpose of the internship is to learn and gain experience in a fast-paced professional repertory process. The intern will work with theatre professionals from around the country putting up a series of shows that will be seen by audiences of approximately 24,000. The exact duties and roles will be specified when internship is awarded.

Expectations

- Intern's chief point person and main administrator of the internship will be CRT'S, Education Director.
- Intern will learn under the supervision with the Education Director and Production Stage Manager.
- Intern will be assigned a CRT staff mentor.
- Intern will be expected to perform in at least one show and understudy 1-2 shows.
- At least 10 hours of the interns weekly schedule will be dedicated to professional development in the theatre field, including 5 guest speakers, 2 masterclasses, intern meetings, rehearsal observation, and more.
- The intern is expected to be highly familiar with their play's text and music before first read.
- Maintain an excellent attitude and work ethic throughout the summer season.
